- 1 How does the corporate partnership work?**

CCU corporate partners sign a non-binding agreement that allows our institution to offer a 10% tuition discount on all online certificates and degree programs to your employees/members.
- 2 What is the cost to become a corporate partner?**

There is no cost to become a partner.
- 3 When will my partnership begin?**

The partnership will begin upon receipt of the signed MOU and completed Questionnaire.
- 4 How long does the corporate partnership last?**

The corporate partnership remains active indefinitely or until either party chooses to discontinue the relationship.
- 5 By becoming a corporate partner, are we agreeing to have our employees/members only enroll at CCU?**

No, the partnership agreement is non-exclusive. It simply means that if any of your employees/members choose to become a student at our institution, they will receive the benefits included in the partnership agreement.
- 6 Can the corporate partnership discount be given retroactively to students already enrolled in the program?**

The discount is only offered to students that enroll after the partnership agreement is signed and remain in active status.
